This Deed made this twenty six day of May in the year of Our Lord eighteen hundred and sixty six by us States Internal Revenue of the sum of sixty dollars, we the said Thos. H. Kemp and Mary Kemp his wife do grant unto Martha A. Smith, all that lot of Land in Pine Neck, Queen Anne's County, Md. which is contained within the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to wit: Beginning in the Public Road from Greenstown to Kent Island, at a corner of Mr. Horner's lot, and running thence North Eighty four degrees West, eighteen perches, thence South fifteen degrees East twenty one perches, thence South sixty nine degrees fifteen minutes East eight perches and seven tenths of a perch, thence South five degrees East nine perches and four tenths of a perch, thence South eighty four degrees East eight perches and thence North eight degrees, west West thirty two perches to the Beginning containing two, acres, two cords and twenty nine perches of land

This Deed made this twenty six day day of May in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred States Internal Revenue and sixty six by us Thomas H. Kemp and Mary Kemp his wife in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty five dollars eighty four cents and three eights of a cent.

We the said Thomas H. Kemp and Mary Kemp his wife do grant unto Peter Horner all that lot of Land in Pine Neck near Winchester heretofore that is contained within the following metes and bounds, courses and distances to wit: Beginning at the end of the division line between the land of said Peter Horner and Jacob W. Blunt and running thence North seventy six degrees East seventy two perches and three quarters of a perch, thence South two degrees thirty minutes East forty perches and one tenth of a perch thence North Eighty three degrees West thirteen perches, thence South eighty eight degrees West twenty six perches and thence South eighty degrees West three perches and eight tenths of a perch to the head of the levee, and thence to the Beginning containing thirteen acres, two cords and twenty seven perches of Land. Also another lot adjoining the above, beginning at the end of the first line of the above lot, and running thence North seventy seven degrees East twenty two perches and a quarter of a perch thence South two degrees
