

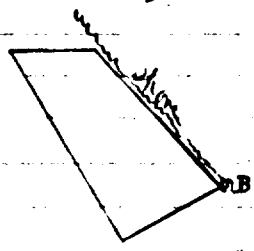

Queen Annes County, to wit: be it remembered, that on the ninth day of June in the year Eighteen hundred and eighty, the following Certificate and Plot were brought to be recorded, to wit:

State of Maryland, Queen Annes County, to wit: Shesly Certify that I have surveyed for Peter Honey a Lot for Oyster Bedding purposes, in the 5th election district of said County on Marshy Creek adjoining the Lot of Marin Hoursey: Beginning at the same Stake and Stone and running with the Shore North forty and three quarter degrees west twenty eight and six tenth perches to a Stake on the Shore then North Eighty nine degrees west thirteen perches to a Stake in said Creek then South thirty degrees East thirty three and three tenth perches to the fourth line of said Hoursey's lot and with that Lot north Sixty five degrees East fifteen and three tenth perches to the Beginning, containing Two and a half acres of planting or bedding ground.

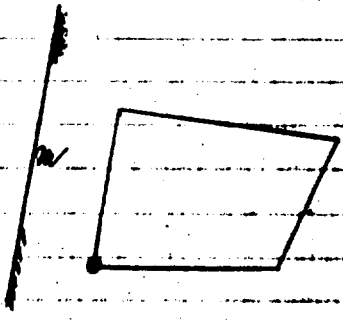

State of Maryland, Queen Annes County, to wit: Shesly Certify that I have surveyed for Mr. E. Ford a Lot for Oyster bedding purposes situated in the 5th Election district of said County on Chester River on the Shore of the land of Mr. F. Ford. Beginning at a Stone on said Shore and running with the Shore North Eighty and a half degrees East Seventy eight and three tenth perches to a Stake, then North fifteen degrees East, Seventy two and four fifth perches to a Stake in Chester River then South eighty six and a quarter degrees west thirty five and three fifth perches to a Stake in Chester River: thence South one and a quarter degrees East twenty four and two fifth perches to the place of Beginning, containing Four and one half acres of Bedding ground.
