Be it remembered that on the 14th day of Oc-  
tober 1808. the following Manumission was  
received to be recorded and on the same day  
was accordingly enrolled as follows to Wit: To all whom it may Concern  
be it known that I Francis Worsley of Talbot County in the State of Mary-  
land for divers good Causes and Considerations me therunto moving as  
also in further Consideration of Fifty dollars to me in hand paid, have released from  
Slavery, liberated, Manumitted and set free, and by these presents do hereby release  
from Slavery, liberate Manumit and set free, my Negro Woman Wether being of  
the Age of Forty three years and able to Work and gain a sufficient livelihood  
and maintenance; and her the said Negro Woman named Wether I do declare  
to be henceforth free, Manumitted and discharged from all manner of Sla-  
very, or Service to me my Executors or Administrators forever In Testimony  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this thirteenth  
day of October in the year of our Lord Eighteen Hundred and Eight.

ted and discharged from all Services to him or to any claiming under him  
and to be free and Manumitted, according to the Act of Assembly in such
