This Release, made this 25th day of July in the year 1902, by Baltimore Building and Loan Association of Baltimore City, a Corporation organized under the laws of the State of Maryland, and Fred M. Robinson and Randolph Barton, Receivers thereof, Witnesseth: Whereas by Mortgage bearing date the 20th day of March, 1894, under the hand and seal of Edward Stallings and Annie A. Stallings the ground and premises therein described or mentioned became limited and secured unto the said Baltimore Building and Loan Association of Baltimore City, for the purpose of securing the payments of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars and interest, as set forth in said mortgage as by reference thereto, recorded among the land records of Queen Anne's County, Maryland, in Liber N. 56, folio 152-153-154 well more fully appears and Whereas the said Annie A. Stallings hath fully paid to the said Baltimore Building and Loan Association of Baltimore City the entire amount of the aforesaid mortgage debt, and all interests thereon accrued as said Association, through its Receivers, hereby admits and acknowledges, wherefore this instrument is executed, Now Therefore this Release Witnesseth that in consideration of the premises and of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), the said Baltimore Building and Loan Association of Baltimore City does hereby grant and release unto the said Annie A.
