This deed, made this fourth day of March in the year one thousand nine hundred and two by the Male and Female Beneficial Association of colored people of Union, Queen Anne's County a body corporate of the State of Maryland, Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of \$1000.00, the said The Male and Female Beneficial Association of colored people of Union Queen Anne's County does hereby grant and convey unto William H. Freely, his heirs and assigns all that piece or parcel of land situated and lying in the Seventh Selection District of Queen Anne's County Maryland and particularly described as follows: Beginning for the point to a point in the middle of a road and at the northwest corner of the land hereby intended to be conveyed and running with said road south eighty nine degrees and thirty minutes east eight and thirty four hundredths perches, thence south thirty minutes west, nineteen and one half perches, thence north eighty nine degrees and thirty minutes west eight and thirty four hundredths perches and thence north thirty minutes east nineteen and one half perches to the place of beginning and containing one acre of land, more or less, being lot 1033 number four of the old Perry Wilson property, as divided by Mrs. B. J. Hunt, Surveyor Queen Anne's County adjoining the lands of Mrs. Mary J. Wright and others, and being a part of the land
