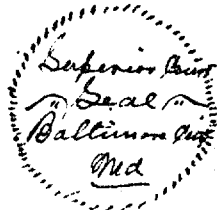

This Mortgage, made this 16<sup>th</sup> day of February, in the year Eighteen hundred and ninety eight, by S. Harry Jones and Annie H. Jones, his wife, of Queen Anne's County, in the State of Maryland. Whereas, by an order of the Orphans Court for Queen Anne's County, passed on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of February 1898, "In the Matter of the Guardianship of William V. Stallings, Samuel J. Stallings, Percy A. Stallings, Edna A. Stallings, Pearl S. Stallings, Della A. Stallings and Emma Stallings, wards of Amelia A. Stallings; - Amelia A. Stallings as Guardian to the said William V. Stallings, Samuel J. Stallings, Percy A. Stallings, Edna A. Stallings, Pearl S. Stallings, Della A. Stallings, and Emma Stallings, all infants under twenty one year of age, was authorized and empowered to invest the sum of seven hundred Dollars of moneys belonging to her wards, which by Petition she had reported to said Orphans Court that she had in hand, in a Mortgage on the Real Estate of S. Harry Jones, subject as to the payment of said principal sum to the order of said Orphans Court, and the payment of the interest to her order as Guardian of said moneys, and the investment to be made
